- I. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairman N. Bleichner at 1:10 p.m. at Heartland Community College in Normal, IL
- II. Roll call and establishment of quorum: Sign-in sheet passed around and quorum was established.
- III. Motion was made by Woolford and seconded by Sparks to approve the 4/12/16 meeting minutes – all in favor - motion carried.
- IV. Financial Report: Motion to approve April & May 2016 expenses made by Woolford and seconded by R. Bleichner – voice roll call vote taken with all voting yea – motion carried.
- V. New Business
 - A. Coordinators report on the June quarterly State Training Board meeting was handed out.
