- I. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Chairman Doran at 1:05 p.m. at Heartland Community College in Normal, IL
- II. Roll call and establishment of quorum: Sign-in sheet passed around and quorum was established.
- III. Motion was made by R.Bleichner and seconded by Travis to approve the 4/11/17 meeting minutes – all in favor - motion carried.
- IV. Financial Report: Motion to approve April & May 2017 expenses made by R. Bleichner and seconded by Sparks – voice roll call vote taken with all voting yea – motion carried.
- V. New Business
  - A. Election of Executive Advisory Board Members for FY2018 - Motion was made by Sparks and seconded by Travis to vote in the slate of officers for FY2018 - voice roll call vote taken with all voting yea with the exception of Doran who abstained - motion carried.   - B. FY2018 dues notices have been mailed.
  - C. Siron stated ILETSB just notified the MTU's they will be receiving \$15,000 in supplemental funds within the next week or so. The funds need to be spent by the end of June and can be spent on items other than training and personnel.
  - D. Siron stated the construction of the academy in Decatur is set to be completed in the Fall with the first class being projected to be held in early 2018.

- E. Hetrick stated ILETSB's IT staff is currently working on a compliance roster program in LEDI to aid departments in keeping track of training mandates that have been met and that need to be met by their officers.

VI. Curriculum

- A. Sparks suggested asking Jason Chambers if he would be willing to instruct some law update courses.
- B. Siron asked if the member agencies would have a need for an FTO Certification or an FTO Update course. Not much need was shown except N. Bleichner stated ISU PD needs to have three officers certified as FTOs.
- C. Siron stated Greg Scott and Brian Brown are planning to set-up EVOC courses on an alternative lot at Rivian to see if they will work in the space. If they will work, EVOC will possibly be held in late September or October.
- D. Siron stated certificates provided by MTU 8 will state when the course has complied with the guidelines of mandates and will list those mandates.
- E. The Executive Institute has some courses that satisfy the mandates on the Online Learning Network now and additional courses will be added. The courses are free of charge.
