- I. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Chairman Doran at 1:05 p.m. at Heartland Community College in Normal, IL
- II. Roll call and establishment of quorum: Sign-in sheet passed around and quorum was established.
- III. Motion was made by Belvery and seconded by N. Bleichner to approve the 10/13/20 & 2/9/21 meeting minutes – all in favor - motion carried.
- IV. Financial Report: Motion to approve February & March 2021 expenses made by Sandage and seconded by Kemp – voice roll call vote taken with all voting yea – motion carried.
- V. New Business
 - A. FY2022 Slate of Officers – The current slate of Officers was nominated by Sandage and seconded by Belvery. Motion was made by Sandage and seconded by Cornwall to close nominations – all in favor – motion carried.
 - B. Doran stated he met with Siron a few weeks ago. Funding is still an issue. ILETSB’s staff will be expanding. Hetrick noted MTU 8 had recently received another quarter of the FY 2021 second quarter payment. That brings the total State funding received to \$117,397.63. The approved FY2021 budget was \$268,337.00. There is a possibility the MTU may receive additional funds prior to the end of the fiscal year. ILETSB stated \$1 million in general revenue funds were sent to the Comptroller in February but those funds have not been released to date. Hetrick stated ILETSB is working on the curriculum for the mandates with a 7/1/21 effective date.
 - C. Jesse Lanphear spoke about the GRACIE defensive tactics instructor course he and a few others from member agencies attended. He stated they taught good techniques and thought some of the techniques could be implemented into MTU 8’s current defensive tactics course.

- A. Hetrick stated the Basic Traffic Crash Investigation course scheduled for 5/17-5/19/21 currently has low enrollment.
- B. Ten seats remain available in the Tactical Emergency Casualty Care course scheduled for 5/20/21. Each participant will receive a tourniquet, pressure bandage and chest seals.
- C. Hetrick stated The Basic School Resource Officer course scheduled in June currently has six enrolled and the current minimum is 12.
