- I. Call to Order: Meeting was called to order by Vice Chairman Bleichner at 1:05 p.m. at Heartland Community College in Normal, IL

- VII. New Business
 - A. Siron stated that the MTU Budget meeting with the State Board would be held on June 21. We are still unsure of our finances but have heard from others that there is funding that was higher than anticipated. We will have a better idea of where we stand after the budget meeting.
- VIII. Curriculum
 - A. A discussion was held in reference to the future instructors for PPCT training as we have experienced a loss of lead instructors and we need a commitment that allows our current instructors to teach future courses. There was also a discussion about implementing training that has been developed by the Department of Justice.

- B. Siron stated that the State is now requiring a Form E to be completed by each instructor of any MTU training. This would also include those courses conducted by individual agencies that are submitted to meet training mandated through the MTU. This does not apply to those that conduct firearms qualifications as long as it is not intended to meet any mandates.

- X. Public Input – Wilson stated that ILEAS training was being moved to an alternative location due to maintenance issues at the ILEAS facility.
